

# DRIVE OUT, PICNIC & VISIT TO FILCHING MANOR MOTOR MUSEUM



Situated in the beautiful East Sussex countryside close to Eastbourne, Filching Manor Motor Museum is only possible to visit by special arrangement. The collection, housed in the grounds of the charming Filching Manor, was originally put together by the late Paul Foulkes-Halbard and is now being continued by his son, Karl. The collection contains the very rare 1898 Orient Express (one of only two left working in the world), a 1907 Corbin Racer, several Bugatti cars, Fangio's very own racing car (the Alesso), a fantastic 1904 chain-driven Mercedes racing car, in addition to the record-breaking K3 Bluebird boat and other famous Campbell cars. The Filching Manor collection is one of few motor museums that has most of its collection in working order.

The plan for the day is as follows:

- Assemble at The Frankland Arms for a leisurely, scenic drive to the museum through the Sussex countryside (departing at 11am)
- Picnic at the museum in the grounds of the manor (in cars if wet!)
- Museum visit (& then make your own way home)
